CCRTL meeting follows 6:30-7:45. Open to public. Community Room, 600 NE 136 Ave.



GOSNELL: The trial of America’s biggest serial killer will be shown at Kiggins Theatre, Jan. 15, Tuesday at 7pm. Contact St. James Church to purchase tickets at 360-693-3052.

“Gosnell” was first scheduled in Clark County for Oct. 12 at Cinetopia, Vancouver Mall. It never showed there. The Columbian reported nothing about this and refused to print the following letter to the editor emailed Oct. 6.

“Gosnell: an inconvenient truth.”

“Gosnell, the movie, comes out this Friday, Oct. 12. Expect little media coverage of this “inconvenient truth” movie about the Philadelphia abortion doctor Kermit Gosnell and the drug investigation which led to his trial and conviction on 3 counts of murder and 1 count of involuntary manslaughter.

The movie trailer identifies three “fact avoiding tactics” pro-abortionists use: gender, race and religion. The prosecutor is told her political career is over if she takes the case since the doctor is black and a champion of women’s rights to late-term abortion. The defense attorney tells the jury Dr. Gosnell

is the victim of an over-zealous Catholic investigator.

Unfortunately for Gosnell, the jury applied the law to the facts of the case, which actually showed a blatant disregard for the health and safety of the women whose children he was aborting. One of them, a 41 year old woman of color, died due to pain medication overdose administered by an untrained employee of Gosnell at his direction. Three or more of the babies were still alive after late-term abortions and directly killed by the doctor.
