BABY SOCKS TRAVEL TO D.C.

RTL member lobbies representatives to support Pro-Life legislation

Sixty-six babies are aborted every day in Washington State. Many of the 66 moms making this tragic choice have devastating effects after abortion, both physical and emotional.

On a recent trip to Washington DC, a CCRTL member, Ruth, spoke with aides of Washington State Senator Patty Murray and Washington State Congressman Brian Baird. She discussed with them the damage that abortion causes to women, and how requiring informed consent could decrease these effects. Ruth also asked each representative to support S-270 & HR 605 for "Programs to reduce abortion, help women bear healthy children and support new parents." Also, HR 649 "To ensure that women seeking an abortion receive an ultrasound and the opportunity to review the ultrasound before giving informed consent to receive an abortion."

On the trip, Ruth brought 66 pairs of baby socks – each one representing one baby killed each day from a legal abortion here in Washington State. Pictures were taken with the socks in front of the White House and the Capitol Building. The socks and the pictures will be displayed at the Clark County Fair booth.
