Prayer, fasting, peaceful witness at the local abortion business...begging God to change the hearts of abortion-minded parents and abortion workers. Will you commit to daily prayer and sacrifice to accomplish this? Will you come to the public vigil and offer prolife information about alternatives to abortion to passersby?

Planned Parenthood provides both chemical and surgical abortions at 5500 NE 109 Court, Suite A in Orchards just west of Gher Rd, north of SR 500 and south of Coxley Dr. Nationwide, Planned Parenthood performs over 300,000 abortions every year. Our efforts in Vancouver, WA since 2009 have made a difference: Read about three lives saved – that we know of – during our local campaign.

October 2010... Young woman sent by boyfriend who wanted her to get rid of the baby. She sees our banner: "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you." – GOD. Then sees the sign "It's not too late to choose life." She tells a praying volunteer: "I'm not going to kill my baby. My family will help me."

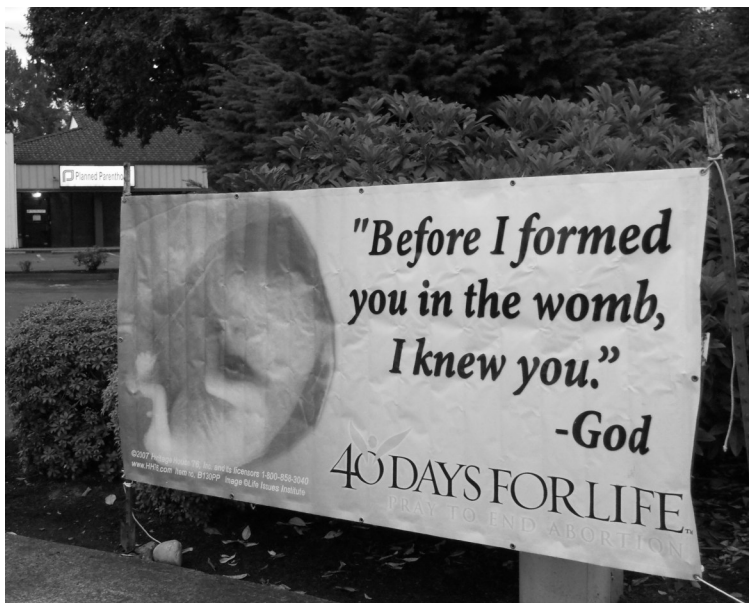

Sometime in 2009... Young woman drives to abortion clinic. She is pregnant, not married and does not tell her mother. She sees the volunteers praying and the banner reminding her that God knew her and her baby from all eternity. She turns her car around, goes home, tells her mother. A year later her mother tells one of our volunteers: "I'm a grandmother today because someone was praying in front of the abortion clinic when my daughter drove there for an abortion. "

March 2009... Man and his girlfriend see the banner with the picture of the beautiful child in the womb and stop to tell the praying volunteers:

"We came here today for abortion. We changed our minds and are going to have our baby and give our baby up for adoption. Thanks for being here today! "

PLANNED PARENTHOOD IS RUNNING SCARED!

In May of this year, the U.S. House passed a bill to defund Planned Parenthood. Unfortunately the Senate did not. So our tax money is still flowing into the abortion industry.

The 332,278 abortions Planned Parenthood performed over the 365 days of 2009 equals an average of 910 lives terminated per day— about 38 per hour, or one every 95 seconds.

Anyone who believes PP is primarily concerned with the health of women and girls needs to look at the record. Here are five facts about PP: (by Charmaine Yoest)

- Planned Parenthood is the nation's largest abortion provider, performing (and profiting from) one out of every four abortions in the United States.
- Planned Parenthood increases its abortion numbers with each passing year, bucking the nearly 20-year national trend of a decreasing abortion rate.
- Planned Parenthood affiliates have failed to be good stewards of taxpayer funds.
- Planned Parenthood fights reasonable laws to protect women and girls because such laws might undermine its ability to make money.
- Planned Parenthood partners with those who sexually abuse and exploit women and girls.

Many people don't know that the Susan G. Komen Foundation partners with Planned Parenthood in 19 communities across America. Although the awarded grant money is to be allocated only for breast cancer screenings, PP is not an organization to be trusted to fight for women's health. When making a donation to Race for the Cure, there is no way to designate your money so that it does not go towards the Planned Parenthood grants. Is this the best organization for life-affirming citizens to be supporting?" You might consider an alternative. The National Breast Cancer Foundation (www.nationalbreastcancer.org) provides mammograms for women in need, as well as breast cancer education and support. The Breast Cancer Prevention Institute (www.bcpinstitute.org) conducts research into the causes of breast cancer, with the goal of reducing the incidence of breast cancer by educating women about avoidable risk factors.
